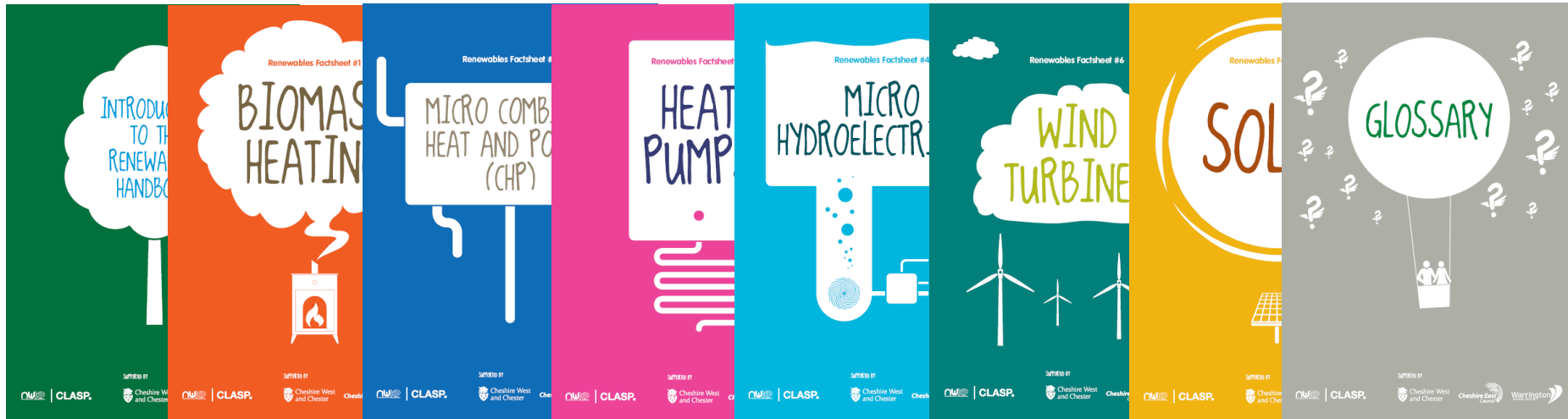
## Cheshire & Warrington Skills Fund Programme Information projects
